This minor is available to any student who wishes to pursue an accounting career with the goal of becoming a CPA. This is an opportunity for SUNY Canton students to earn a minor in accounting, regardless of their undergraduate major, and give them the basic undergraduate courses necessary to complete an MS in Accounting. It allows accounting transfers from community college to earn the minor in Accounting, complete a baccalaureate degree, and then enroll in the MS in Accountancy.
