- * Completed at least two quantitative courses (JUST 347 - Research Methods in Criminology & CJ, SSCI 370 – Research Methods, and/or MATH 141 – Statistics)

- * Select one course from MA core requirements (Theories of Crime, Theoretical Foundations of Criminal Justice, Applied Statistics, & Research Design)
- * Select three courses from criminal justice electives
