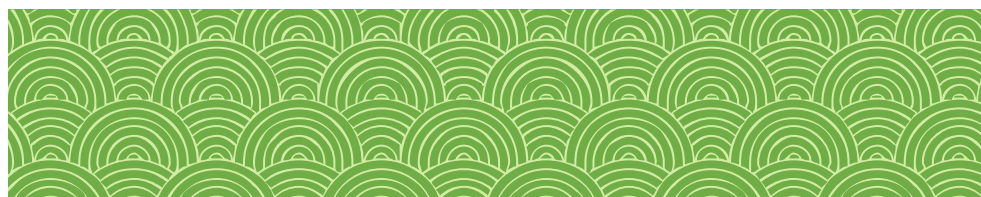
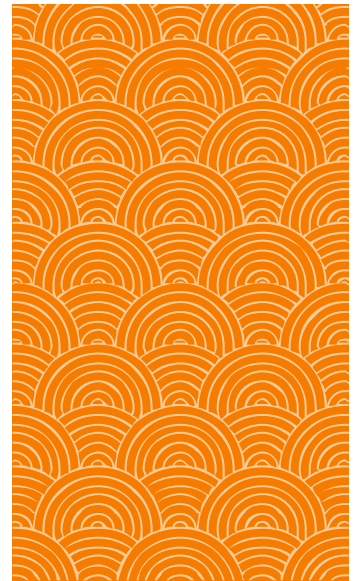
Outcomes:

3. Assessment Mapping Workshop
